

Flower Blanket – Snowdrops

Hook size: 4.5mm for all parts.

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in Grass Green, White, and Spring Green.

This pattern is written in US terms

US Terminology

SC – single crochet

HDC - half double crochet

DC – double crochet

SLST – slip stitch

MR – magic ring

CH – chain

ST - stitch

() – indicate all stitches to be made in one stitch.

Gauge is 17 stitches x 10 rows = 10cm. (Rows of DC).

Square measures 15cm x15cm .

Block Granny Square

1. Use **SPRING GREEN**. In a MR, CH5 (*Counts as 1st DC and CH2*). In ring make (3DC, CH2) three times. Then 2DC and SLST into the 3rd ST of the CH5. (4 sides of 3DC with CH2 between).
2. SLST twice into the previous round CH2 space. CH5, then 2DC in the same CH2 space. Make 1DC in each ST around with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) into the corner spaces. Finish with 1DC in the last corner and SLST into the 3rd ST of your beginning CH5. (4 sides of 7DC with CH2 in each corner).
3. to 5. Repeat Row 2. Making 1DC into each ST with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) into each corner. SLST in 3rd ST of beginning CH5 to join. (Row 6 – each side has 27 stitches with CH2 in each corner).
6. SLST twice into the previous round CH2 space. CH5, then 2DC in the same CH2 space. * Make 1DC in the 1st ST. ** (CH1, skip a ST, DC) twice. Then DC across until 4 stitches remain. Repeat from **. Make (2DC, CH2, 2DC) into the corner space. Repeat from * around. Finish with 1DC in the last corner and SLST into the 3rd ST of your beginning CH5. (Each side has 19DC).
7. Repeat Row 2 but with making 1DC in stitch **and** in each CH1 space. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 27DC with CH2 in each corner).

Snowdrops – Use WHITE – Make 3

1. In a MR make 6SC. SLST in 1st SC to join. (6 stitches).
2. To 3. (CH1, SC) CH1 does not count as a ST. Make 1SC in each ST around. (6 stitches).
4. * CH5. SLST in 2nd CH from hook and loosely SLST down remaining chains. SLST in the next 2 stitches and repeat from * around. Do not SLST to join. (3 petals made).
5. * Work 1HDC up the 1st CH of the CH5 spoke, SC in each of the next 2 chains. At the top in the 4th CH make a SLST. Then working down the other side of the CH, work through (*insert hook under the SLST from previous row and work around it*) the SLST's. Make SC in the next 2 stitches with HDC in the last ST. SLST through the SLST in between the petals. Then Repeat from * for the next petal. SLST in the 1st HDC made to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. (3 petals made).



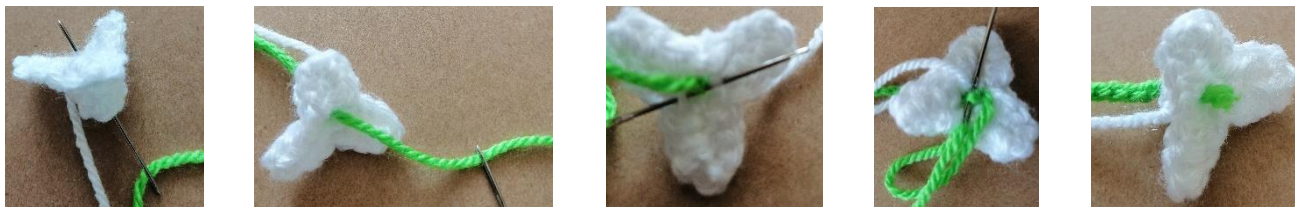
Stems – Use GRASS GREEN

1. Make 2. Leave a long tail before making CH30. Fasten off leaving a long tail.
2. Make 1. Leave a long tail before making CH20. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Leaves – Use GRASS GREEN

1. Large leaf. CH15. SLST in 3rd CH from hook. SC in next 4 chains. HDC in the following 4 chains. DC. DC, HDC, SLST. Fasten off leaving a long tail.
2. Small leaf. CH13. SC in 4th CH from hook and in the next 3 chains. HDC in following 3 chains. 1DC, HDC, SLST. Fasten off leaving a long tail.





Thread the start of a stem chain up through the centre hole of a flower's MR and make a few small stitches to secure it on the inside as it comes out of the hole. Then thread it back through the centre of the thread where it first came into the flower. Leaving a small end, cut and pull it apart so it frays out.

Sew onto the square as in photo. Sew middle flower on first only sewing the snowdrop on by the petal which is touching the square. Use the green chain end to secure the end of the stem, then sew a few stitches up the stem to secure in place. Repeat with the other 2 flowers – the shorter stem goes at the front on the right-hand side. Sew smaller leaf on touching the base of the stems on the right-hand side of the square. Place the larger leaf so the base is touching the smaller leaf.
