
- 1. Using GINGERBREAD in a MR make 12DC. SLST in top of 1st DC to join (12 sts).
- 2. (CH3 counts as 1st DC throughout entire pattern, DC). Make (2DC) in each ST around. SLST in top of beginning CH3 to join. (24 sts).
- 3. CH3, * (2DC), DC. Repeat from * around finishing with (2DC) in the last ST. SLST in top of beginning CH3 to join. (36 sts).
- **4.** (CH3, DC), * DC in the next 2sts, (2DC). Repeat from * around finishing with 1DC in the last 2sts. SLST in top of beginning CH3 to join. (48 sts).
- 5. CH3, * (2DC), DC in the next 3sts. Repeat from * around only finishing with 1DC in the last 2sts. SLST in top of beginning CH3 to join. (60 sts). Fasten off yarn.
- 6. Join ROSE in any ST. (CH4, TR), *TR, DC twice, HDC twice, SC in the next 3sts, HDC twice, DC twice, TR, (2TR, CH2), (2TR). Repeat from * around finishing with in the last ST with (2TR, CH2) and SLST in the 4th CH of the beginning CH4. (Each side has 17sts with CH2 in each corner).
- 7. (CH3, DC) in the corner space. Make 1DC in each ST around with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in each corner space. Finish in the beginning corner space with (2DC, CH2), and SLST in the top of the beginning CH3 to join . (Each side has 21DC with CH2 in each corner).
- 8. (CH2 counts as HDC, HDC) in corner space. Make 1 HDC in each ST around with (2HDC, CH2, 2HDC) in each corner space. Finish in the beginning corner space with 2HDC, CH2, and SLST in the top of the beginning CH2 to join. (Each side has 25HDC with CH2 in each corner).
- 9. Repeat ROW 8. (Each side has 29HDC with CH2 in each corner).
- **10.** (CH2, HDC) in the corner space. Then make* FPHDC, BPHDC across the row finishing with FPHDC in the last ST. Make (2HDC, CH2, 2HDC) in the corner space. Repeat from * around finishing in the beginning corner space with (2HDC, CH2) and SLST in the 2nd CH of the beginning CH2 to join. (Each side has 33HDC with CH2 in each corner).
- 11. Repeat ROW 10. (Each side has 37HDC with CH2 in each corner).
- 12. CH1 does not count as a ST. In the corner space make (2SC). Make 1SC in each ST around with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in each corner space. Finish in the beginning corner space with (2SC, CH2) and SLST in the top of the 1st SC to join. (Each side has 41SC with CH2 in each corner).
- **13.** CH1. In the corner space make (1SC). Make 1SC in each ST around with (SC, CH2, SC) in each corner space. Finish in the beginning corner space with (1SC, CH2) and SLST in the top of the 1st SC to join. (Each side has 43SC with CH2 in each corner).
- 14. Repeat ROW 13. Fasten of yarn. (Each side has 45SC with CH2 in each corner).



Pudding Icing

- 1. Using WHITE in a MR make 6DC. **DO NOT** join. (6 sts).
- 2. TURN WORK .(CH3, DC). Make (2DC) in each ST across. (12 sts).
- 3. TURN WORK. (CH3, DC), * DC, (2DC). Repeat from * across finishing with a DC in top of the CH3. (18 sts).
- 4. TURN WORK. (CH3, DC), * DC twice, (2DC). Repeat from * across finishing with a DC in the last 2 sts. (24 sts).
- 5. TURN WORK. (CH2, HDC), * HDC in the next 3sts, (2HDC). Repeat from * across finishing with 1HDC in the last 3 sts. (30 sts).
- 6. DO NOT TURN WORK. Working across the bottom of the icing. In the side of the last ST make ** (2HDC, DC, 2HDC). Skip the next row (Row 4), SC in the side of the next row (Row 3). Skip a row (Row 2) and make * (HDC, DC, 2TR, DC, HDC) in the side of the next row (Row 1). SLST into the centre of the MR.







Make * in the next row end. Skip a row, SC in the end of the next row, skip a row and make ** in the last ST. Working around the curved edged of the icing make 1SC in each ST along finish by making a SLST in the top of the 1st HDC ST— the beginning ST of Row 6. Fasten off yarn leaving along tail . Line up icing with the top of the pudding on square and using long tail end sew into place.





Berries - Make 3

1. Using RASPBERRY CH2. In the 2nd CH from the hook make a (5DC bobble, SLST). To make the bobble ST, YO, insert hook, pull through, YO, and pull through 2 stitches. Repeat this 4 more times. You will end up with 6 loops on your hook, YO and pull through all of the loops on the hook. Fasten off leaving along tail. Sew onto centre top of icing as in main photo.

Holly Leaves - Make 2

- 1. Using PERIDOT CH9. SC in the 2nd CH from the hook, HDC twice, DC twice, HDC twice. (SC, CH2, SC) in the last CH. Working down the other side of the CH, HDC twice, DC twice, HDC twice, SC. SLST in the 1st SC to join.
- 2. (CH1, SC), (SLST, SC, CH2, SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook SLST) –Holly Point made. Skip a ST. In the next ST (Holly Point). SLST, In the next ST (Holly Point). SLST in the next 2sts. SLST into the CH2 space (SC, CH3, SLST in the 3rd CH from the hook, SLST). SLST in the next 2 sts. (Holly Point), SLST, (Holly Point), Skip a ST, (Holly Point), SLST in the next 2 sts. SLST into the centre ST, CH3. SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and in the next CH. Then across the centre line of the holly make a SC in each ST along. SLST in the last ST before the point and fasten off yarn leaving along tail.
- **3.** Sew onto the square at an angle so that the holly stalks just touch under the berries.







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Snowman Square

Hook Size: 4mm

Yarn: Deramores Studio DK 100% acrylic yarn.

250meters/ 273yards.

Blue Haze (Lighter Blue), Sky (Dark Blue), Raspberry (Red), Burnt Orange (Orange), Gingerbread (Brown), Black & White.

<u>Square</u>

- 1. Using RASPBERRY in a MR, CH5 counts as DC and CH2, then in ring make (3DC, CH2) 3 times. Then 2DC and SLST into the 3rd ST of the CH5. (4 sides of 3DC with CH2 between).
- 2. SLST into the corner CH2 space. (CH5, 2DC), * (DC, CH1) in the 1st ST, skip the next ST. DC in the next ST and make (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in the CH2 corner space. Repeat from * around finishing with a DC in the beginning corner space and SLST into the 3rd CH of the beginning CH5. (Each side has 6DC with CH1 in the centre and CH2 in each corner space).
- 3. 10. SLST into the corner CH2 space. (CH5, 2DC), * Make 1DC in each ST across, CH1 and skip a ST at each CH1 space. Work (2DC, CH2, 2DC) into the corner space. Repeat from * around finishing with a DC in the beginning corner space and SLST into the 3rd CH of the beginning CH5. (Row 10 Each side has 38DC with CH1 in the centre and CH2 in each corner space).
- 11. SLST into the corner CH2 space, (CH3 counts as a SC and CH2, 2SC). * Make 1SC in each ST and CH1 space around with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) into each corner space. Repeat from * around finishing in the beginning corner space with 1SC and SLST into the 1st CH of the beginning CH3. (Each side has 43SC with CH2 in each corner space).
- 12. SLST into the corner CH2 space, (CH3 counts as a SC and CH2, SC). * Make 1SC in each ST and CH1 space around with (SC, CH2, SC) into each corner space. Repeat from * around finishing in the beginning corner space with a SLST into the 1st CH of the beginning CH3. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 45SC with CH2 in each corner space).

Snowman Body

- Using WHITE in a MR, make 10HDC. SLST in 1st HDC to join. (10sts).
- 2. CH1 at the start of each round do this for all rounds. CH1 does not count as a ST throughout. (2HDC) in each ST around. SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (20sts).
- **3.** * HDC, (2HDC). Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (30sts).
- **4.** * (2HDC), HDC in the next 2sts. Repeat from * around finishing a SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (40sts).
- 5. * HDC in the 1st 3 sts, (2HDC). Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (50sts).
- **6.** * (2HDC), HDC in the next 4sts. Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (60sts).
- 7. * HDC in the 1st 5 sts, (2HDC). Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st HDC to join. (70sts).
- 8. SC in each ST around. SLST in the 1st SC to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail (70sts).



Snowman Head

- 1. 5. Repeat ROWS 1-5 of the snowman body.
- **6.** SC in each ST around. SLST in the 1st SC to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail. (50sts).

Bobble Hat

- Using SKY join in any ST between ROWS 4 & 5 of the snowman head. (CH3-counts as 1st DC, DC). Make 1DC in the next 14sts.
 (2DC) and SLST into ROW 7. (18sts).
- 2. CH3- counts as 1st DC. * FPDC, BPHDC. Repeat from * across. Finish with a DC in the top of the beginning CH3 and SLST into ROW 7. Fasten off yarn. (18sts).







3. Join BLUE HAZE in the 3rd ST of the SKY band. Go through the BACK LOOP of the SKY and through BOTH loops of the WHITE behind. Make 1HDC in the next 14 STS, leaving the remaining sts unworked. (14sts).





- **4.** CH1 and TURN at the start of each of the remaining rows. (HDC2TOG). HDC in the next 10sts. (HDC2TOG). (12sts).
- 5. (HDC2TOG), 1HDC in the next 8sts. (HDC2TOG). (10sts).
- **6.** (SC2TOG), SC, HDC, DC, DC, HDC, SC, (SC2TOG). (8sts).
- **7.** CH1, Skip the 1st ST. SC, SLST, SC twice, SLST, skip a ST and SC in the last ST. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail.
- **8. Pompom** Using **SKY** make a small pompom. Either use a small pompom maker or use a fork. Using a fork , wrap yarn around the outside prongs. Cut a long strand and thread through the centre prong. Secure with a tight knot. Cut end sides. Remove from fork and trim if need.

Carrot

- 1. Using BURNT ORANGE CH2. Make (2SC) in the 2nd CH from the hook. (2sts).
- 2. CH1 and TURN. Make 1SC in each ST. (2sts)
- 3. CH1 and TURN (2SC), (2SC). (4sts).
- **4.** CH1 and TURN Make 1SC in each ST across. (4sts).
- 5. CH1 and SC in the side of the last ST. Make 1SC in each ST around the carrot with (SC, CH2, SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook, SLST) in the end point. SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. Sew onto face as in photo.

Features

- 1. For the eyes I used 2 small safety eyes or you can make eyes using the same pattern as the button.
- 2. For the mouth using **BLACK** sew 3 dashes 2 stitches long and 1 stitch apart for the mouth.







Button

 Using BLACK in a MR make 6SC. SLST in the 1st SC to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail. Sew onto Snowman just below where the scarf crosses. (6sts).

Scarf

- 1. With SKY CH5. SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and across. (4sts here and throughout pattern).
- 2. 4. (CH1 and TURN CH1 does not count as a ST, SC). Make 1SC in each ST across. **DO NOT** fasten off carry yarn up side of scarf.
- 5. 8. Join BLUE HAZE and repeat ROW 2. DO NOT fasten off carry yarn up side of scarf.
- 9. Continue making 4 rows of each colour until 15 stripes are made and ending on the SKY band. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. Cut 4 short lengths of each colour. Fold strand in half, insert hook into the end ST of scarf and pull the loop partially through. Remove hook and pull the tail ends around and through the loop. Pull tight tassel made. Repeat this for the other 3sts alternating colours. Then repeat for the other scarf end.
- **10.** Place scarf so that it just sits behind the top of the snowman body. Pin into place. Cross over scarf ends and using the long tail end stitch into place.











Right Twig Arm

1. Using GINGERBREAD CH15. SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and in the following 5ch's. CH5, SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and in the next 4ch's. Then continue making SLST's down each CH of the beginning CH15. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail.

Left Twig Arm

1. Using GINGERBREAD CH13. SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and in the following 3ch's. CH7. SLST in the 2nd CH from the hook and then in all remaining CH's. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. Stitch arms into place just under the sides of the Snowman body.

Sewing onto square

 Place snowman's head so it just overlaps the body and touches the cross of the scarf. Pin into place. Sew onto the centre of the background square. Sew Pompom on top of bobble hat.



- 3. CH1 and TURN. CH1 does not count as a ST throughout. . Make 1SC in each ST across.
- 4. Make 1SC in each ST across change back to BLUSH in the last ST. DO NOT fasten off PEONY carry end up the side of work.

Large Parcel Ribbons

2. Using a long piece of CITRINE yarn fold in half and thread under where the ribbon crosses. Make a bow and cut off ends. Place on the square on the 2nd row across and stitch in place.







Middle Parcel

- 1. Using BLUSH CH16. SC in the 2nd CH from the hook and in each CH across. (15 stitches here and throughout pattern).
- 2. 15. SC in each ST across.
- **16.** CH3 and SC in the side of the end ST. Working around the square make 1SC in each ST around with (SC, CH2, SC) in the corners. SLST in the 1st CH of the beginning CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail.

Middle Parcel Ribbons - Use CITRINE. Make 2

Leaving a long tail before starting CH25. Fasten off leaving along tail. Using the long tail ends sew on middle parcel diagonally
with the wrong side of the chain facing. Using a long strand thread through where the ribbons cross and tie a bow. Sew
middle parcel onto the square slightly angled so it overlaps the large parcel. See main photo.

Small Parcel

- 1. Using PEONY CH10. SC in the 2nd CH from the hook and in each CH across. (9 stitches here and throughout pattern).
- 2. 3. CH1 and TURN. SC in each ST across.
- 4. SC twice, B To make a BOBBLE change to BLUSH in the ST before. BOBBLE STITCH (4DC's together). This ST will always be worked on the WRONG SIDE of your work. - **3.** (CH1, SLST), SLST, SC twice. (2HDC), (2DC), (2TR), DC. HDC, SC in the next 3sts the last SC will be in the top of the CH3 and SLST into the end ST of the **RASPBERRY** row. Fasten off yarn. (13sts).





4. Join **RASPBERRY** in the top left ST of the stocking. (CH1, SC). Make 1SC in each ST around the stocking with (2SC) in the middle ST of the stocking front and (2SC) in the middle ST of the stocking heel. When you reach the top right corner ST make a SC and CH15. SC in the same ST and continue making 1SC in each ST along the top of the stocking. SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off leaving along tail. Pin stocking onto square slightly angled. Sew stocking onto square leaving the top edge of the stocking open – so it becomes a pocket.


- 1. Right side Using WHITE and a 3mm hook. CH5. (SC2TOG) in the 2nd & 3rd Ch's from the hook. SC, (2HDC, SLST). Fasten off yarn leaving a tail to sew onto Santa's face just above the mouth.
- **2.** Left side CH5, (SC, 2HDC), SC, (SC2TOG, SLST). Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail sew onto face so that it touches the right side of the moustache.




3. Make a small pompom using the 2 prongs of a fork. Wrap WHITE yarn around the 2 prongs. Then cut a long piece of yarn and tie around the centre tight. Cut up the side of the prongs to make a pompom, trim and sew onto the edge of Santa's hat.

- **1.** Using **RICO GOLD**, sew little crosses over the centre of the 4 snowflakes as in photo.
- **2.** Using **RICO GOLD** and a 4mm hook, leaving a long tail first CH11. Fasten off. Sew onto Row 52 where the bag goes in slightly.
- **3.** Leaving an end, CH15. Fasten off leaving a long tail. Fold in half and sew into place as centre tie on sack.







Join & Border

Hook Size: 4mm

Yarn: Deramores Studio DK 100% acrylic yarn.

250meters/273yards.

Sky (Darker Blue), Raspberry (Red) & Frost (White).

Rico Gold Lame DK



1. Layout squares as shown in finished blanket photo. Starting with the right top 2 squares – (Rudolf and the White Snowflake). Place the right sides together – Place the snowflake (1) on top of the reindeer square (2). Using SKY join in the corner CH2 space in the top ST and make 1SC in BOTH loops of each square. Continue making 1SC in both loops down the squares. Make 1SC in the corner CH2 space.



- 2. Join the next 2 squares. Place the next reindeer square on top of the white snowflake square (3 &4) and SC in the CH2 corner space. Carry on making 1SC in both loops of both squares finishing with a SC in the CH2 space before joining the next 2 squares, the blue snowflake and the parcel stack (5 & 6).
- 3. Repeat Row 2 joining squares Pudding and Snowman (7 & 8). Then the Christmas tree and stocking (9 & 10). Fasten off yarn.
- 4. Continue down the next column 3. Joining the Sparkly parcel to the White snowflake (11 & 1) in exactly the same way as the previous row. Place the parcel square on top of the white snowflake square and join yarn in the top CH2 corner. Then work 1SC in both loops down the side of the squares. Finishing with a SC in the CH2 space. Then join the next 2 squares (12 & 3) etc.
- **5.** Carry on joining the 3rd column to column 2 in the same way as Row 4.
- 6. Join the 4th Column to the 3rd Column in exactly the same way joining squares 14 & 15 to the large square (22).
- 7. On column 5 join the 1st 3 squares only to the 1st 3 squares in column 4. Finishing with a SC in the CH2 space of squares 21 & 18.
- **8.** Fold down Row 1 onto Row 2 and starting with squares 2 & 4. Join yarn with a SC in the CH2 space, then make 1SC in both loops of all the squares across joining Rows 1& 2 together. Fasten off yarn at end of row.
- **9.** Repeat Row 8 for all the other rows, until all squares are joined together.

Border

- Join SKY yarn in any corner space with a (2SC, CH2, 2SC). * Make 1SC in each ST around the blanket with 1SC in each corner space on each square. At the very end corners of the blanket make (2SC, CH2, 2SC). Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn.
- 2. Join RASPBERRY yarn in any corner space. (CH4 counts as HDC and CH2, HDC), * CH1, skip the next stitch, HDC in the next stitch. Repeat from * around blanket with (HDC, CH2, HDC) in each corner space. Finish with a SLST in the 2nd CH of the beginning CH4 to join. Fasten off yarn.
- Join FROST in any corner space. (CH4, HDC). * CH1, make 1HDC in the CH1 space from the previous row. Repeat from * around with (HDC, CH2, HDC) in each corner space. Finish with a SLST in the 2nd CH of the beginning CH4 to join. Fasten off.
- **4.** Join **RASPBERRY** and repeat ROW 3. Fasten of yarn.






Finishing Touches

1. Using RICO GOLD and starting with the Rudolf Square. Join yarn at the back of reindeer's coloured collar. Make SC surface stitches in a slight curve shape so that it joins the next reindeers collar. Repeat this for the reindeers. Then link the last reindeer's collar to the top edge of the sleigh. Fasten off yarn.
