| Yarn used | MC - 23 g of Green DK yarn from personal stash <br> Kit Yarn <br> CC1 - Purple <br> CC2 - Rich Plum <br> CC3 - Yellow <br> CC4 - Orange <br> CC5 - Red |
| About the yarn | DK |
| Tension (please fill this in, even for toys) | $23 \mathrm{sts} \times 11$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$. Rows of dc. |
| Hooks used | 3.5 mm |
| Other supplies | Tapestry needle, scissors |
| Sizing | Christmas Tree Bag - $18.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ <br> Present bag $-11.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ |
| Hints and tips | Do not fasten off bobble stitch colour, drop yarn end and pick up on the next bobble stitch row - less ends to sew in! <br> Make small balls of each colour - do not carry yarn across use a new ball for each colour section. <br> Change yarn colour on the final yrh of the stitch before the colour change is indicated, leaving the yarn on the WS ready to use again on the next row. |
| Special stitches/abbreviations | Bobble Stitch (bbl): [Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pul, yrh draw through 2 loops] 5 times into same stitch, yrh, draw through all 6 loops on hook. <br> Bobble stitches will always be worked on the wrong side of work. |
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## Christmas Tree Bag

With CC1 ch32.

1. (rs). Dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each st across, turn. (31sts).
2. (ws) - 3.(rs). 1ch - does not count as a st throughout pattern, dc across. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail end.
3. (ws). Join CC4, 4ch - counts as tr and 1ch, * miss 1 st, tr. Rep from * to end. Fasten off. (16sts).
4. (rs) - 12. (ws). Join MC. 1ch, 1dc in each st and in each 1ch space across, turn. (31sts).
5. (rs). $1 \mathrm{ch}, 15 \mathrm{dc}$ in MC, 1 dc in CC1, 15 dc in MC. Turn.
6. (ws). 1ch, 14dc in MC, 1bbl in CC4, 2dc in CC1, 14dc in MC. Turn.
7. (rs). 1ch, 13dc in MC, 5 dc in CC1, 13dc in MC. Turn.
8. (ws). 1ch, 12 dc in MC, 1 dc in $C C 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $C C 3$, 2 dc in $C C 1$, 1 bbl in CC 4 , 2 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,12 \mathrm{dc}$ in MC . Turn.
9. (rs). 1ch, 11 dc in MC, 9 dc in CC1, 11dc in MC. Turn
10. (ws). 1ch, 10 dc in MC, 2dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC5, 2 dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC3, 2 dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC 4 , 2dc in CC1, 10dc in MC. Turn.
11. (rs). Rep Row 15.
12. (ws). $1 \mathrm{ch}, 12 \mathrm{dc}$ in $M C, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in $C C 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $C C 5,2 \mathrm{dc}$ in $C C 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $C C 3,1 \mathrm{dc}$ in $C C 1,12 \mathrm{dc}$ in $M C$. Turn.
13. (rs). Rep row 17.
14. (ws). 1ch, 10dc in MC, 6dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC5, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC3, 1dc in CC1, 10dc in MC. Turn.
15. (rs). 1ch, 9dc in MC, 13dc in CC1, 9dc in MC. Turn.
16. (ws). 1ch, 12dc in MC, 1 bbl in CC4, 5 dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC 5 , 12dc in MC. Turn.
17. (rs). Rep row 17.
18. (ws). 1ch, 10 dc in MC, 1 dc in $C C 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC3, 2 dc in $C C 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $C C 4,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 1,10 \mathrm{dc}$ in $M C$. Turn.
19. (rs). Rep row 23.
20. (ws). 1ch, 8 dc in MC, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC5, 2dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC3, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC4, 6 dc in CC1, 8 dc in MC. Turn.
21. (rs). $1 \mathrm{ch}, 7 \mathrm{dc}$ in MC, 17 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,7 \mathrm{dc}$ in MC. Turn.
22. (ws). 1ch, 10 dc in MC, 2dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC5, 2 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC 4 , 2dc in CC1, 10dc in MC. Turn.
23. (rs). Rep row 23.
24. (ws). 1ch, 8 dc in MC, 1 bbl in CC4, 5 dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC5, 2 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC3, 2dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC4, 2dc in CC1, 8dc in MC. Turn.
25. (rs). Rep row 29.
26. (ws). $1 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{dc}$ in MC, 1 dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC3, 2 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 4,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC 5 , 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC3, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC4, 2dc in CC1, 6dc in MC. Turn.
27. (rs). 1ch, 5 dc in MC, 21 dc in CC1, 5 dc in MC. Turn.
28. (ws). 1ch, 4 dc in MC, 2dc in CC1, 1 bbl in CC5, 2 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC 3 , 2dc in $\mathrm{CC} 1,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in CC 4 , 5 dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC5, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC3, 2dc in CC1, 1bbl in CC4, 2dc in CC1, 4dc in MC. Turn.
29. (rs) - 40. (ws). 1ch, 14dc in MC, 3dc in CC2, 14dc in MC. Turn.
30. (rs) $\mathbf{- 4 5}$ (rs). 1ch, with MC dc across. Turn.
31. (ws) - 49 (rs). Rep rows 37-40.
32. (ws). - 81. (rs). Working the pattern in reverse. Starting with Row 36 - work back up the pattern repeating rows from 36 down to row 5 . Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail of MC.
33. (ws). Rep row 4.
34. (rs). - 86 (ws). Join CC1, 1ch, dc across. Fasten off.

## Edging

1. With RS facing join CC5 in the $1^{\text {st }}$ st in Row 1. dc across the top of the bag. Fold bag in half and continue to dc across row 86 of the back of the bag. Slst to join. (62sts).
2. $1 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*}$ (dc, 2ch, slst). Miss a st. Rep from * around bag. slst to join. Fasten off. (31sts)
3. Turn bag inside out, using the long tail ends sew sides of bag together using a mattress st.

## Cord

1. With CC5 CH160. Dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. Tie a knot at each edge of the chain. Thread through chain spaces on bag and secure with a bow.

## Star - make 2

1. With CC3 in a MR (dc, 2ch, slst in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, dc, slst) 5 times. Slst to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. Sew onto bag at the top of the tree.

## Present Gift Bag

With CC1 ch26.

1. (rs). Dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (25sts).
2. (ws) - 3.(rs). 1ch - does not count as a st throughout pattern, dc across. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail end.
3. (ws). Join CC3, 4ch - counts as tr and 1ch, * miss 1 st, tr. Rep from * to end. Fasten off. (13sts)
4. (rs). Join CC4. 1ch, 1dc in each st and in each 1ch space across, turn. (25sts).
5.     - 10. (ws). 1ch, dc in each st across, turn.
1. (rs). - 14. (ws). 1ch, 4 dc in $\mathrm{CC} 4,17 \mathrm{dc}$ in CC 2.4 dc in CC 4 , turn.
2. (rs). 1ch, 6dc in CC4, 13dc in CC3, 6dc in CC4, turn.
3. (ws). $1 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 4,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 3,1 \mathrm{bbl}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 5,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in $\mathrm{CC} 3,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in CC 4 , turn.
4. (rs) - 18.(ws) Rep rows 15 \& 16 .
5. (rs). Rep row 15.
6. (ws). 1ch, 6dc in CC4, ( 1 bbl in CC5, 1 dc in CC3) 6 times. 1 bbl in $\mathrm{CC} 5,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in CC4. Turn.
7.     - 24. (ws). Rep rows 15 \& 16 twice.
1. (rs). Rep row 15.
2. (ws) - 30. (ws). Using CC4, 1ch, dc across, turn.
3. (rs). - 35.(ws). Rep rows 15-19.
4. (ws). Rep row 20.
5. (rs). - 41. (rs). Rep rows $21-25$.
6. (ws) - 45. (rs). Rep rows 11 - 14.
7. (ws) - 51. (rs). Using CC3, 1ch, dc in each st across, turn.
8. (ws). Rep row 4.
9. (rs). With CC1, 1ch, dc in each st and in each 1ch space, turn.
10. (ws) $\mathbf{- 5 6}$ (ws). 1ch, dc across. Fasten off yarns leaving a long tail of CC4.

## Bag edging - repeat rows 1-3 of the Christmas Tree Bag Edging.

## Cord

1. With CC2 ch110. Dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. Tie a knot at each edge of the chain. Thread through chain spaces on bag and secure with a bow.

## Bow - make 2.

1. With CC5 ch61. Slst in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook. Dc in each ch across with a slst in the last st. Fasten off. Tie into a bow shape and sew onto bag above the top bobble stitch on the present.
